1.	Short-term Visitor Accommodation (VA) Activities  The purpose of this workshop was to provide Elected Members with an update on preliminary analysis undertaken on alternative tools (including the development of a local act) to manage the impacts of short-term visitor VA on the district's housing availability and affordability challenge, and to seek feedback from Elected Members to guide possible next steps.  Luke Place and Emily Irwin spoke to a PowerPoint presentation (Attachment B). Staff responded to questions.	Request to explore other tools for managing short-term VA, e.g. a local act, potential changes to the District Plan, and the use of rating.
