

#### ROAD TO ZERO WANAKA - Ballantyne Rd / Golf Course Rd intersection





- Project has currently been deferred to be undertaken during the next NLTP LCLR programme. Delay due to incomplete Developer / adjacent land owners negotiations.
- Option for 'Peanut' Roundabout fully designed and ready to tender/construct if that decision is made. Alternative more standard 4 leg roundabout may still be an option depending on land take requirements.
- Short term a mini roundabout has been installed. Some minor adjustments are to be made to this to allow it to continue operating safely.






