

Town Centre Arterial Road

We made it! Traffic is now flowing and we hope you're enjoying using the new road.

We are now focusing on the side roads at Ballarat, Malaghan and Beetham Street to create safe pedestrian access routes into the town centre. Upper Beetham Street is open, with upper Ballarat Street due to open by the end of the month, followed by Malaghan Street.

We have returned to lower Ballarat Street near Horn Creek, to continue installing a stormwater pipe and the outfall structure. Next week, we will begin work at the Stanley Street (SH6A)/Ballarat Street intersection as we complete the final connections for the stormwater network.

We'll keep you updated as these dates may change due to weather, resources, or other circumstances.

Reminders: Ballarat / Stanley St Stormwater upgrade

LOWER BALLARAT STREET IS CLOSED BETWEEN STANLEY AND CAMP STREET FROM MONDAY 10 FEBRUARY – MONDAY 16 MAY 2025.

- No general access to and from Athol Street and Lower Ballarat Street. Residents and businesses can still access Athol Street. Businesses and the KFC drive-through can be reached from Shotover Street.
- Coach stops on Athol Street will move temporarily to the old Playcentre site on Stanley Street from Monday 10 February until Wednesday 19 February, after which they will return to Athol Street.
- Night works are planned Wednesday 19 February – morning of Monday 17 March, from 10.00pm to 10.00am Sundays to Thursdays. We've worked closely with affected local businesses to agree this timing, and it means people can continue to access Brazz and Speights Ale House during the day.

THE STANLEY/BALLARAT STREET (SH6A) INTERSECTION WILL CLOSE FROM WEDNESDAY 19 FEBRUARY – THURSDAY 24 APRIL. PLEASE BE AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- The arterial road will be the alternative route into and through the town centre.
- Public bus stops on Stanley Street will be relocated. Check out the Orbus website and Facebook page for information about changes during this time.
- Carparks will be closed, including the off-street carparks on Ballarat /Stanley Street and on-street parking on Ballarat Street.
- Business and pedestrian access remain on Stanley Street for Super Liquor, Toad Rentals, Life's A Grind Espresso, 50 Stanley Street and the Queenstown District Court. Any detours will be clearly signposted.
